Important Notes Regarding Change of Visa Status:

- (1) If you are in a different visa status than F-1 or J-1 at this time, and you are planning to change your status to F-1 or J-1 while you are inside the U.S., be aware that the approval process can take three to six months. You should allow ample time to complete this process.
- (2) Changing your status while you are inside the U.S. will not obtain an F-1 or J-1 visa stamp in your passport. The next time you travel outside the U.S., you will need to go to a U.S. consulate or embassy abroad to apply for an F-1 or J-1 visa, before you can reenter the country.
- (3) Attempting to change visa status from B-1 or B-2 to F-1 or J-1 while inside the U.S. is generally not advisable. For this change of status, you are encouraged either to travel outside the U.S. to apply for an F or J visa or to contact an immigration lawyer to assist you in resolving your situation.

Transfer Information

If you are transferring to Mount Saint Mary’s University from another U.S. school, including language schools, you must have your SEVIS record released to Mount Saint Mary’s by the school from which you are transferring. This must be done by the authorization date indicated on your SEVIS Transfer Authorization Form. Documents required to effect your transfer will be sent to you upon your admission to Mount Saint Mary’s University.

Important Notes to Applicant Regarding Proof of Funding:

- (1) Make and submit additional copies of the relevant page, if you have more than one financial sponsor.
- (2) For each source of funding, attach corroborating financial documentation, either in English or with a certified English translation, dated no more than three months before its submission to Mount Saint Mary's University.
- (3) Documentation of scholarships and fellowships may be in the form of an official award letter from the school or sponsoring agency.
- (4) Documentation of personal or sponsor funds must be provided either on this form or on an original sheet of the bank's letterhead stationery. In either case, the documentation must bear a bank official's signature, the bank's stamp, or the bank's seal. Documentation also may be provided in the form of a legally binding affidavit.
- (5) Sponsors who are U.S. citizens, U.S. permanent residents, or legally present in the U.S. must submit a completed Form I-134 Affidavit of Support, with financial documentation in English dated no more than three months before its submission to Mount Saint Mary's University. 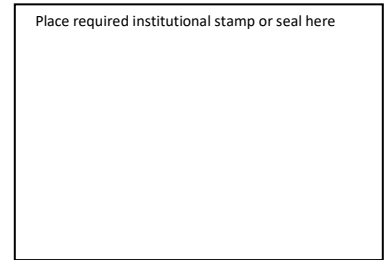
