

# CARES Act Request Form

MSMU will be receiving funds under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The CARES Act is intended to provide emergency cash grants to students who have experienced unexpected costs or financial hardship related to the COVID-19 Pandemic disruption of the academic semester and the move to fully online learning. This includes educational related expenses as well as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care.

The funds are available for graduate and undergraduate students. Students do not need to already be receiving federal financial aid in order to qualify to receive this assistance however only students who are eligible to apply for federal financial aid may receive funding under the CARES Act.

These funds are not part of a financial aid award and eligible students may use these funds to address whatever emergency financial needs they are experiencing. **Students enrolled in fully online programs prior to the COVID-19 disruption of on campus programs are not eligible to receive funding per the federal guidelines.**

Your request will be reviewed and we may contact you for further information. The amount of CARES Act funding MSMU has received is limited therefore it is possible not every application will be approved. In order to best assist as many students as possible the amount of assistance you receive may be less than your actual expenses listed in your application for funds.







**UPDATE:** Due to the high volume of applications from students in need, we expect to allocate all available CARES Act funds to students who have already applied. You are welcome to submit an application and it will be reviewed. However, applications received after May 8, 2020 are subject to available remaining funds from the federal allotment.

## Next Steps

If you are awarded assistance under the CARES Act, the grant funds will be disbursed to your student account. If you have not already signed up for eRefund (Direct Deposit of credit balances) through Self-Service, please do so by entering your bank information in order to get the funds to you quickly. Students who do not provide their banking information for eRefund will be issued paper checks, which could take up to 10 days to receive and are subject to US Postal Service delays.
