

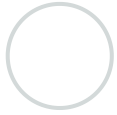

Over 20% of young people have experienced mental illness, but only 4% of our overall healthcare budget goes toward mental health services. 14% of our students will have disabilities, from learning disabilities to mental illness. **Reviewing our sources for this module, discuss how disabilities impact our students, and how our social services (health care, education, social work, etc.) support our students - or don't.**

Synthesize the podcasts, the article, and your textbooks to demonstrate your understanding of social services for our students with disabilities. **Draw connections to your teaching practice and reflect on how your understanding of this balance is important to your role as a teacher.**
